Emmanuel Drabo (HE program) received the "Outcome Award" at the Senior Awards Banquet on May 7th.



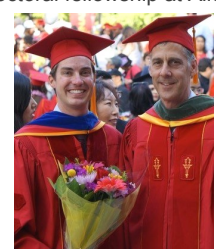
